Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel

ATCO Structures & Logistics built permanent staff housing for the Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel. The facility, which accommodates 600 people and is situated next to the hotel, was constructed to complement the historic hotel and its distinct architecture.

ATCO's design team worked to incorporate various elements reflecting architectural styles prevalent in Banff National Park and provided comfortable staff accommodations.

The units were manufactured in ATCO's Calgary facility and shipped to site for final assembly and exterior finish.

The slope in the roofs was designed to prevent snow buildup in winter. The exterior also featured local river rock and log trim. Each unit was built with its own self-contained kitchen.

The facility continues to provide comfortable and functional accommodation at this historic hotel.
